Quick reminder for everyone else, there will be no HOMEROOM next Monday, we will be on a normal Schedule!

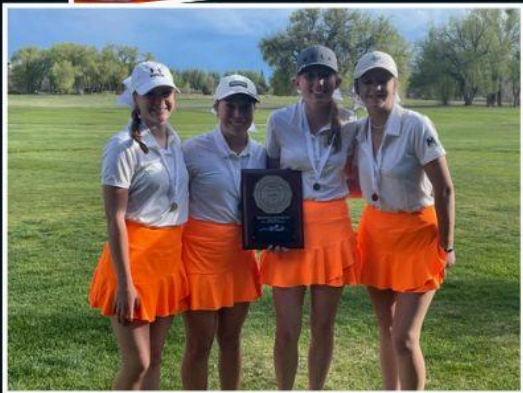

STUDENT LEADER SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM June 1 – Aug. 31, 2024

Students must:

- Be enthusiastic about volunteering to save lives!
- Acquire basic knowledge about blood donor eligibility and the blood donation process.
- Plan to spend a **minimum of 5 hours** actively recruiting blood donors to your virtual blood drive.
- Be enrolled in, or planning to enroll in, a post-high school educational institution accredited in the United States in fall 2024 or spring 2025. Community college, trade school, college, university, and post-graduate studies qualify.

This is a non-competitive scholarship program: you can earn as much as \$1,000 by encouraging people to give blood. Scholarships will be paid directly to the school, in the student's name, at the end of the program. Students of any age who have completed high school and are planning to advance their education, and students who have received other Vitalant scholarships in the past, are eligible. For the full list of guidelines, visit vitalant.org/scholarship. **Students must meet all program requirements to be eligible for a scholarship.**

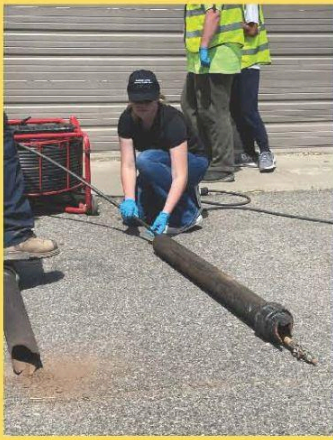

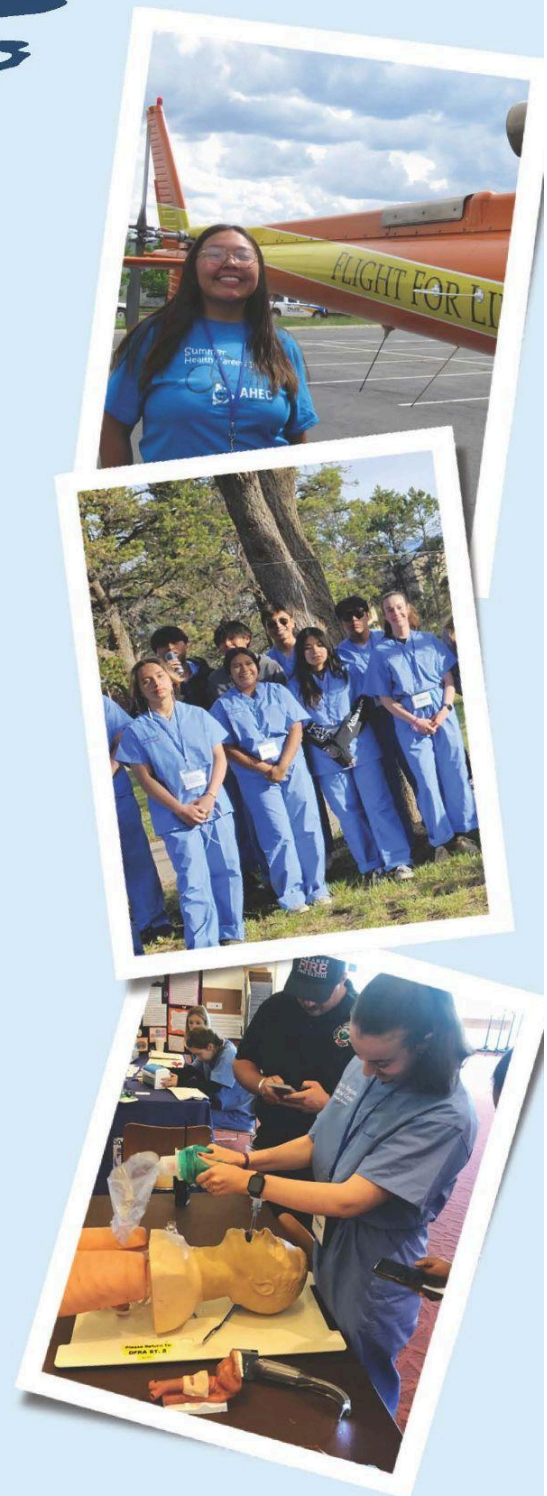

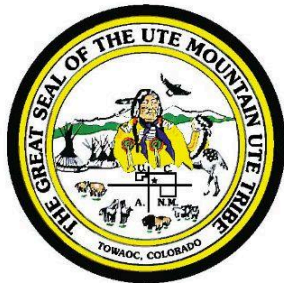

Native Education Forum

Monday, June 3 – Friday, June 7, 2024

APRIL 5 IS THE DEADLINE FOR PRIORITY REGISTRATION

The Native Education Forum (NEF) is a pre-collegiate program for Native American high school students. The five-day summer program is designed for rising high school seniors and incoming CSU freshmen.

Through this on-campus residential program, students will gain university classroom experience, earn one academic credit, research issues critical to tribal communities, and begin navigating the university application process.



Career Pathways

By participating in NEF, students learn more about the different majors and careers available at CSU by engaging with Native American faculty and current CSU undergraduates through open dialogue lectures, laboratory tours, and hands-on workshops. Program highlights include Animal Sciences, Agribusiness, Land Conservation, Indigenous Studies, and Indigenous STEM education and research.

Academic Research

NEF participants gain university classroom and research experience by conducting small group research projects on contemporary issues in tribal communities. NEF students present their research to family and friends at the closing reception.

Preparation for Admissions

NEF students receive tailored support from CSU admissions and financial aid officers to gain a better

understanding of the admissions process. Participants also learn about outside scholarship opportunities available through regional and national tribal scholarship organizations.

NEF Program Highlights

- Work with CSU faculty, staff and students
- Live and study on a university campus for five days
- Strengthen your college/university application
- Improve your academic research skills
- Earn one college credit

Community of Excellence Partnership Award

Students who participate in the Native Education Forum may be eligible to receive a Community of Excellence Partnership Award of \$2,500-\$5,000 per year. The Partnership Award is an annual award that is renewable for up to 5 years.

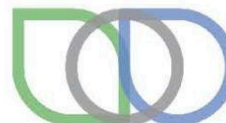

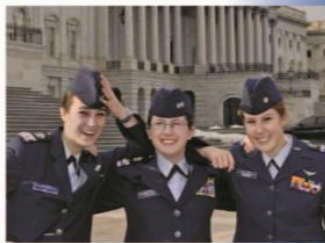

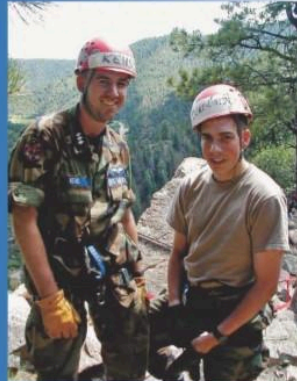

How old do I have to be?
You must be at least 12 but not yet 19 to join as a cadet.

How much time do I have to commit? On average, cadets meet one night a week for 2 hours and enjoy special events one Saturday each month. Week-long camps are held each summer.

How much does it cost? Expenses will be about \$100 to get started in CAP. Depending on participation in activities and fees at your unit, you can expect to spend about \$300 - \$600 in the first year.

Will I be required to join the military? Cadets are never obligated to join the military, but 10% of all Air Force Academy cadets got their start in CAP.

Who supervises the cadets? Adult volunteers, fingerprinted and screened by the FBI, chaperone all cadet activities.

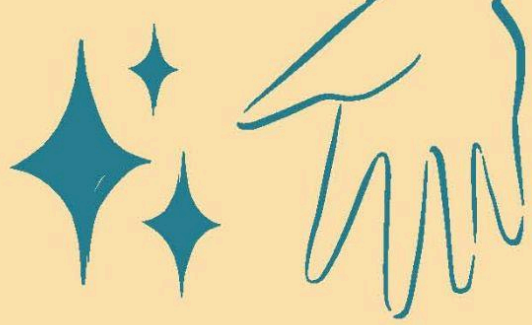

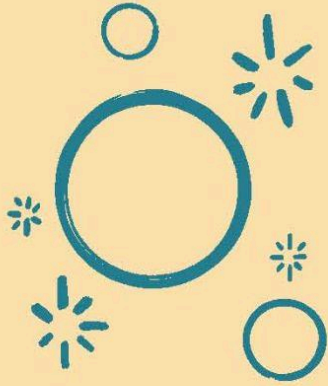
